We visit the local church for harvest festival, Christmas and Easter celebrations linked to **RE**.



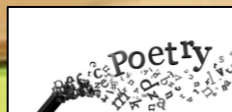
Throughout the year, we all have the opportunity to learn through Forest School sessions.

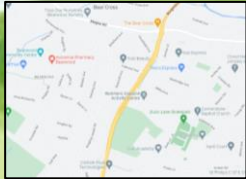
We will be part of the Hillbourne nativity at Christmas where we perform to our parents and carers.

To learn about water **safety**, we are visited by the RLNI. This helps us keep safe in the sea or by the river.

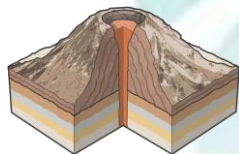


In **DT**, we learn to cook British seasonal food.
