- We learn how to manage our feelings.

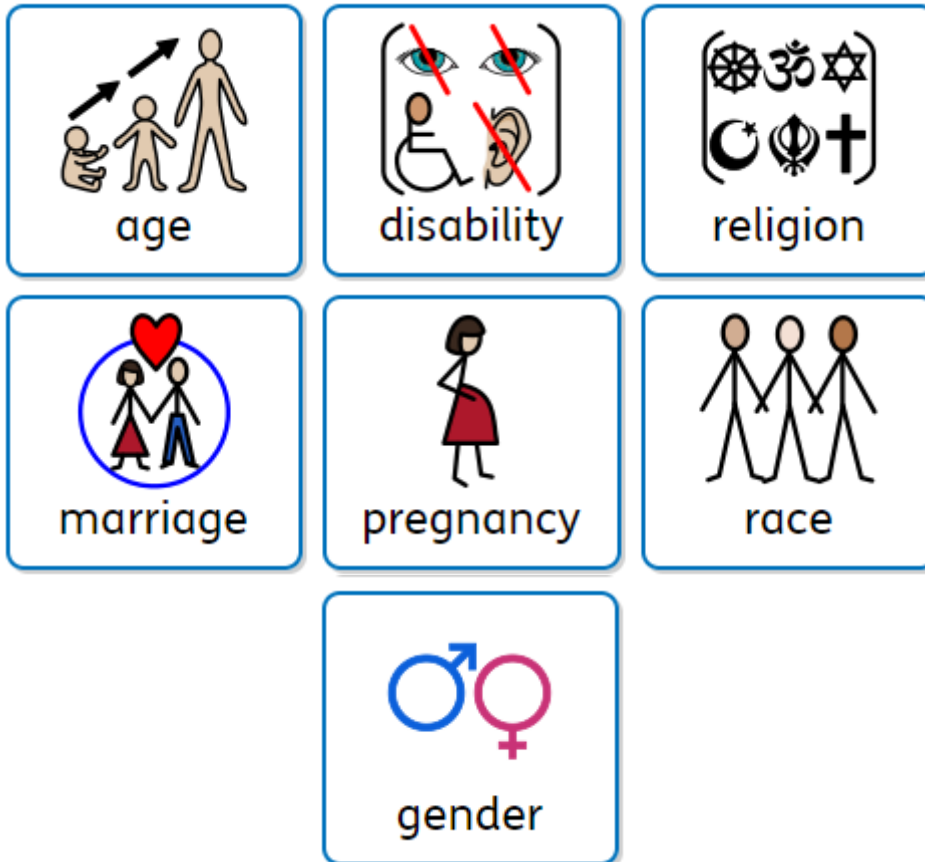
How does the **building** keep us safe?

# Protected Characteristics at Hillbourne

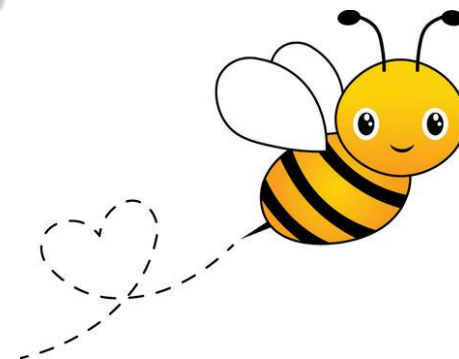
In the **United Kingdom**, it is **illegal** to **discriminate** against someone because of a **protected characteristic**.

## Be Respectful

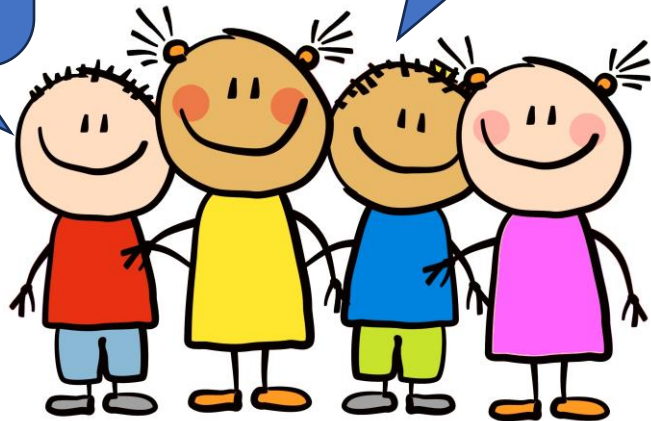
Our school value of **Be Respectful** encourages us to celebrate diversity, be tolerant of others and show kindness.











# Physical Safety at Hillbourne
