



## Being a Reader



The theme of freedom will be explored through our first reading text, 'The Undefeated' by Kwame Alexander and Kadir Nelson. During this unit, the children will begin asking questions and making predictions as we read as well as studying the features of poetry. Children will also learn about the significance of Black History in America and compare and contrast this to life today.

## Being an Author



In writing we will begin with the book Varmints by Helen Ward & Marc Craste. A beautifully powerful narrative about the impacts of destroying nature. We will begin by looking at features of an explanation text, writing our own about the life cycle of a living thing. We will then explore the use of fronted adverbials and modified noun phrases to write our own narrative.

## Being a Mathematician



**Number** - This half term, we will be focusing firstly on recapping Column Addition and Subtraction. The children will learn to represent, partition, order and compare numbers to 10,000.

## Being a Scientist



Our Science topic this term is 'Electricity'. We will understand that electrical energy is one of many forms of energy, name common appliances that use electricity and understand the significance of Thomas Edison and Joseph Swan.

## Being an Athlete



The children will be focussing on developing their skills of throwing, catching, shooting and moving by playing Dodgeball. They will also develop their knowledge and understanding of Outdoor Adventurous Activities (OAA).

## Being a Historian



In History we are exploring the concepts of Empire, Invasion, Invention and Technology through studying the Romans. We will learn about key figures and how Roman inventions influence the world today.

## Being an Artist



In Art, the children will be learning to improve their mastery of drawing techniques using a range of materials. We will be creating self-portraits.

## Being a Citizen



Our key question in PSHE is 'How do we treat each other with respect?'. We will explore permission and consent, boundaries, bullying and as part of our safety curriculum how to remain safe around water.

## Being a Philosopher



In RE we will be studying Judaism and the relationship Jewish people have with God. The children will investigate the story of Abraham and Isaac, God's promise to the Jewish people and Moses and the ten commandments.

## Being a Linguist



Children will learn how to present themselves, including saying hello/goodbye, numbers and where they live.

## Being a Musician



In Music this term, we will be focusing on interesting time signatures. Our music learning will also include singing practice.

## Being a Computer Scientist



The children will become picture editors and learn how to alter images using professional editing software. When they have mastered this they will move on to learning about Computing Networks, Systems and the Internet.
