Year 6 Beach Trip

Dear Parents & Carers,

We are pleased to announce that we are celebrating the achievements of Year 6 with a trip to Bournemouth Beach on **Tuesday 21st July 2026**. The children will be departing school at approximately 9:15am and will leave the beach at 2:00pm, therefore, there will be no change to the school time.

Once we arrive at Bournemouth Pier, the children be taking part in a minigolf session at the Smugglers Cove before enjoying games on the beach. At lunchtime, we will be providing a choice of sausage and chips; chicken chunks and chips; battered fish chunks and chips; or a portion of chips. The children will be making their choices in class and this will be ordered ahead of time. If you have any allergy concerns or dietary requirements, please contact the office as soon as possible. Therefore, the children do not need to bring in a packed lunch but they can bring in a snack if they wish and a refillable bottle will be needed.

During the trip, the children will be asked to wear their P.E kit, including suitable shoes for walking, to help us stay safe as one group. Please check the forecast beforehand if additional clothing is needed; long-lasting sunscreen should be applied in the morning but we ask for children not to bring it with them due to an allergy. We would also recommend bringing a hat and sunglasses if we are expecting a sunny day. We will not be allowing the children to go into the water; therefore, swim clothing will not be required. If children are not able to follow the school values of ready, respectful and safe before the trip or on the day of the trip, they will unfortunately not be able to attend and alternative provision will be provided at school.

We are very grateful to the HoH who have very kindly contributed to this school trip meaning there is a heavily reduced cost of £6.50 per child. We are asking for a voluntary contribution to enable this visit to go ahead to cover the cost of transportation and admission fees. If you have any concerns about the cost, please contact us, as we have financial assistance available. Children entitled to pupil premium will receive a 50% discount on the above price. Please make payment and give permission for your child to attend the trip via the MCAS app.

This is a provisional booking and unfortunately if we do not receive enough payments **by Friday, 10th July**, then the trip will not be able to go ahead. We believe that this trip will be a great opportunity to celebrate the children's achievements of their time at Hillbourne.
